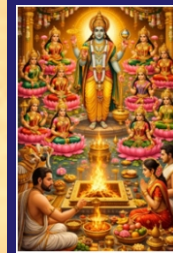
### Lakshmi Hayagriva

Hayagriva, an avatara of Vishnu, is worshipped as the embodiment of knowledge and wisdom, depicted with a human body and a radiant horse's head, symbolizing the triumph of divine knowledge over ignorance and darkness. He is shown holding books, the conch,



and discus, and is revered as a powerful protector and bestower of learning who uplifts devotees with clarity and grace.

### Ashta Lakshmi Dhanvanthari



Performing Ashta Lakshmi Dhanvantari Puja invokes the combined blessings of the eight forms of Lakshmi for wealth, prosperity, and overall abundance in life. It also brings the grace of Lord Dhanvantari for good health, protection from ailments, and holistic well-being.

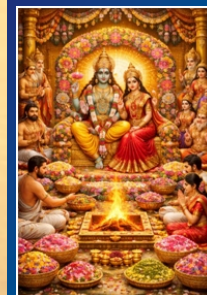
### Bhoo-varaha Swamy Puja

Worship of Bhoo Varaha Swamy symbolizes the divine rescue of Mother Earth and restoration of balance in life. It is believed to remove land-related obstacles, financial difficulties, and vastu doshas. This pooja brings stability, prosperity, and protection to home and family.



It invokes blessings for harmony with nature and overall spiritual upliftment.

### Srinivasa Kalyanotsavam and Sri Pushpa Yagam



Kalyanotsavam and Sri Pushpa Yagam are sacred rituals dedicated to Lord Venkateswara and Goddess Padmavathi, symbolizing divine union, devotion, and the offering of pure love through flowers. These ceremonies invoke blessings for prosperity, harmony in relationships, removal of obstacles, and spiritual upliftment in the lives of devotees.

## Why does Lord Narasimha stand behind Lord Sudarshana?

**Divine Oneness:** Traditionally all aspects of Lord Vishnu are considered manifestations of the one supreme divinity. As such, Sudarshana Chakra is not separate from Vishnu but an embodiment of his divine power, just like Yoga Narasimha. The placement of Yoga Narasimha behind Chakrathalwar symbolizes their shared divine essence, both originating from Vishnu's supreme energy. **Protection and Strength:** Another interpretation highlights their protective and formidable roles. Chakrathalwar (Sudarshana Chakra) is an eternal shield, protecting devotees from harm. Yoga Narasimha, the fierce incarnation of Vishnu, represents unmatched strength, ready to vanquish evil when necessary. By positioning Yoga Narasimha behind Chakrathalwar, it signifies the immense power that fuels the divine shield, ever watchful and prepared to unleash its force when required. This arrangement beautifully conveys the balance of protection and potency, ensuring devotees' safety and righteousness through Vishnu's boundless grace.

## Who is Lord Sri Narasimha?

Narasimha is the fourth incarnation of Lord Vishnu who killed the demon Hiranyakashipu with body of a man and head of a lion. It is believed that Lord Narasimha will fulfill the desires of his devotees whenever they face threats from their enemies. Narasimha homam plays a key role in ensuring the protection of a person by destroying the evil forces. It also provides methods for getting peace of mind from potential threats to live a safer life. Anyone who wants to overcome debts and fear problems in life can choose this homam for achieving goals
